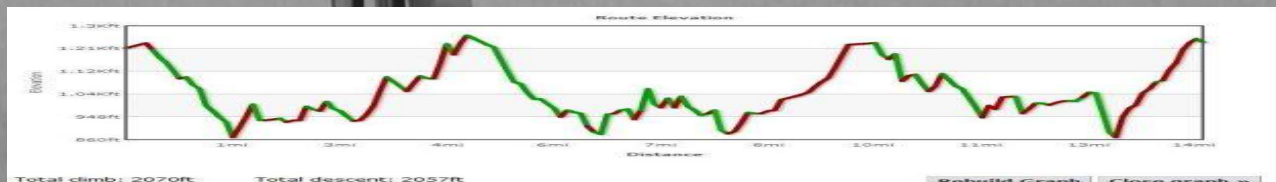

TIME TRIAL

March 20, 2010

Held under USAC permit

Battle it out against the clock on one of the hardest time trial courses in Southwest Missouri. This is a section of the course used for the Tour of Missouri time trial in 2007 and 2008, which the pros called one of the hardest time trial courses they had ever done.

This will be an out and back 14 mile TT on the scenic Ozark Mountain High Road which includes 4 climbs and 4 descents. MODOT has granted us use of the left lane both directions to minimize any traffic conflicts. This highway has low traffic volume.

Directions: The High Road is located south of Springfield off of US 65. take US 65 south to the Ozark Mountain High Road exit then turn right, the start of the time trial will be where the High Road ends at 76 highway. Parking will be located in this area. The parking will be on a slight slope but should accommodate trainers.

Time: First rider will go off at 11:01 with 1 minute intervals for each rider.

Rules: All USAC rules apply. USAC license required. Helmets required for all riders. Organizer has the right to combine categories and adjust times as needed.

Registration: Pre-register on <http://www.BikeReg.com/events/register.asp?eventid=9906>

Riders without a USC license may pre-register and purchase one day license at A&B Cycle. Starting times will follow the order of registration, riders pre-registering first will be given the earlier start times. Same day registration will open at 9:30.

Prizes: The fastest time of the day will be awarded a trophy sculpture.
